I. IDENTITY OF MOVING PARTY

II. STATEMENT OF RELIEF SOUGHT

Appellants ask the Court to accept their Notice of Appeal that was filed with the Whatcom County Superior Court on November 4, 2024, or in the alternative grant an extension of time until the Court acknowledged the filing on November 22, 2024.

III. FACTS RELEVANT TO MOTION

On December 11, 2024, this Court sent a letter to counsel for appellants in which it said that “The “NOTICE OF APPEAL TO SUPREME COURT” filed in the Whatcom County Superior Court on November 22, 2024, was forwarded to this Court by the Whatcom County Clerk.” The Court’s statement came as a surprise to appellants because they filed their Notice of Appeal with the Whatcom County Superior Court on November 4, 2024.
